

Parent Teacher Meeting in the College

The first Parent-Teacher meeting was held by different Honours departments in the college on **26th of September, 2016 (Monday)** from 11.00 a.m. The attendance of the parents along with the wards was recorded by different departments.

The parents were informed regarding the progress of the syllabus, the examination schedule of the college and the performance of the students in the classrooms and their participation in other activities of the college. Parents were requested by the faculty members to keep in touch with the subject teachers as and when needed and to send their wards by 10.15 a.m (when the college starts) to the college and to attend all theory and practical classes (for science subjects) along with pass subjects regularly. The guardians in the Chemistry and Geography Department have suggested the teachers to organize regular class tests in both theory and practical
