These led to the development of thinking skill, stimulating creativity, growth of interest in science, improvement of logical capacity for logical thinking and initiation of manual dexterity. Since the models were hand-made by the resource person using regular items that are otherwise discarded, it was easier for all the students, whether from the science department or not, to comprehend the notions behind working of each model.

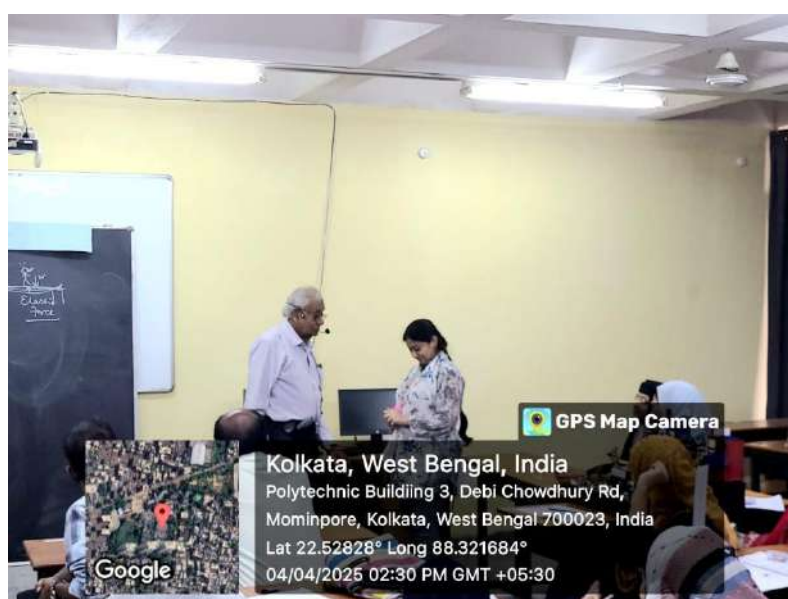
