


Book Grant Facilities Student Welfare Sub-Committee

The Student Welfare subcommittee established in the year 2016 of Government Girls' General Degree College is devoted to ensure the social welfare of students coming from different social background. The prime objective is to provide social equity by granting financial assistance to students belonging to economically backward and under-privileged sections of the society. The members of the subcommittee take every possible effort to provide all types of financial assistance (from the college fund) and scholarship (State Government for all the minority and non-minority students) in order to eliminate the social, cultural and economic barriers that the students from these sections face on regular basis.

One time book grant facilities within the tenure of three years (undergraduate period) are also offered to the needy and meritorious students of the college through an interview . The students apply in plain paper addressing the Principal of the college stating the reasons for why she needs the book grant facilities Based on the family means the candidates are selected for the Book grant during the interview by the subcommittee members in presence of the Principal and IQAC coordinator . The amount also varies amongst the selected candidates based on the needs and family income. The students can buy books /contingency materials or both from the grant given by the college.

Book Grant From W.B Urdu Academy

In addition to the above, the students from the college also receive one time grant from the Urdu Academy for purchasing of books. This facility can be availed only by those students who study Urdu language as one of their subjects in the graduation period and were having Urdu as one of their subjects at 10+2 examination level. The eligibility criteria is to secure more than 75% marks in aggregate at 10+2 level exam

The students who have received this facility mostly belong to Urdu Department, English Department and History Department of the college.
