

Report of Special lecture organized by Department of History

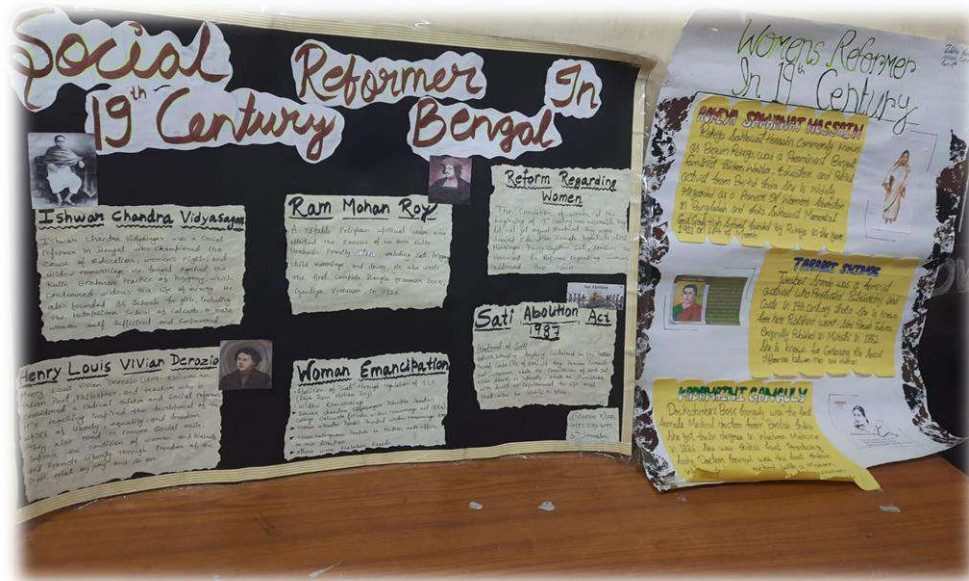

The lecture was delivered by Dr. Maroona Murmu, Professor of History, Jadavpur University. The topic is relevant to a topic of the DSE paper for 5th Semester (Hons).
