Prof. Rupa Banerji suggested that special lectures may be recorded in our YouTube Channel.

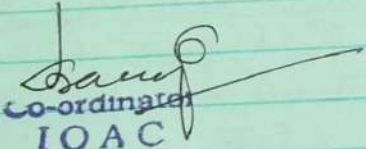
