SCHOLARSHIP FACILITIES STUDENT WELFARE SUB-COMMITTEE

The Student Welfare subcommittee established in the year 2016 of Government Girls' General Degree College is devoted to ensure the social welfare of students coming from different social background. The prime objective is to provide social equity by granting financial assistance to students belonging to economically backward and under-privileged sections of the society. The members of the subcommittee take every possible effort to provide all types of financial assistance (from the college fund) and scholarship (State Government for all the minority and non-minority students) in order to eliminate the social, cultural and economic barriers that the students from these sections face on regular basis.

The Institution promotes its social welfare policy by helping the students hailing from under-privileged economical backgrounds to apply for and avail the existing government scholarship schemes under Aikashree for minority students and OASIS scholarships (for SC, ST and OBC). The other scholarships like Kanyasree and SVMCM for non-minority (funded by HED, GoWB), are also offered to the students from different relevant committees which are created to supervise these mechanisms with utmost dedication. The Jt. Convener Dr. Rajashree Dasgupta acts as the nodal officer for the Aikashree scholarship (under different schemes viz. SVMCM , Post Matric and Talent support)based on marks obtained in the last pass examination. Ms. Sutapa Bose acts as the nodal officer for the OASIS scholarships (offered to SC, ST, and OBC candidates) .Dr.Shabnam Parveen acts as the nodal officer for Kanyasree scholarships. Kanyasree Committee is a separate subcommittee in the college who provides benefit to students applying under the Kanyasree Scheme .

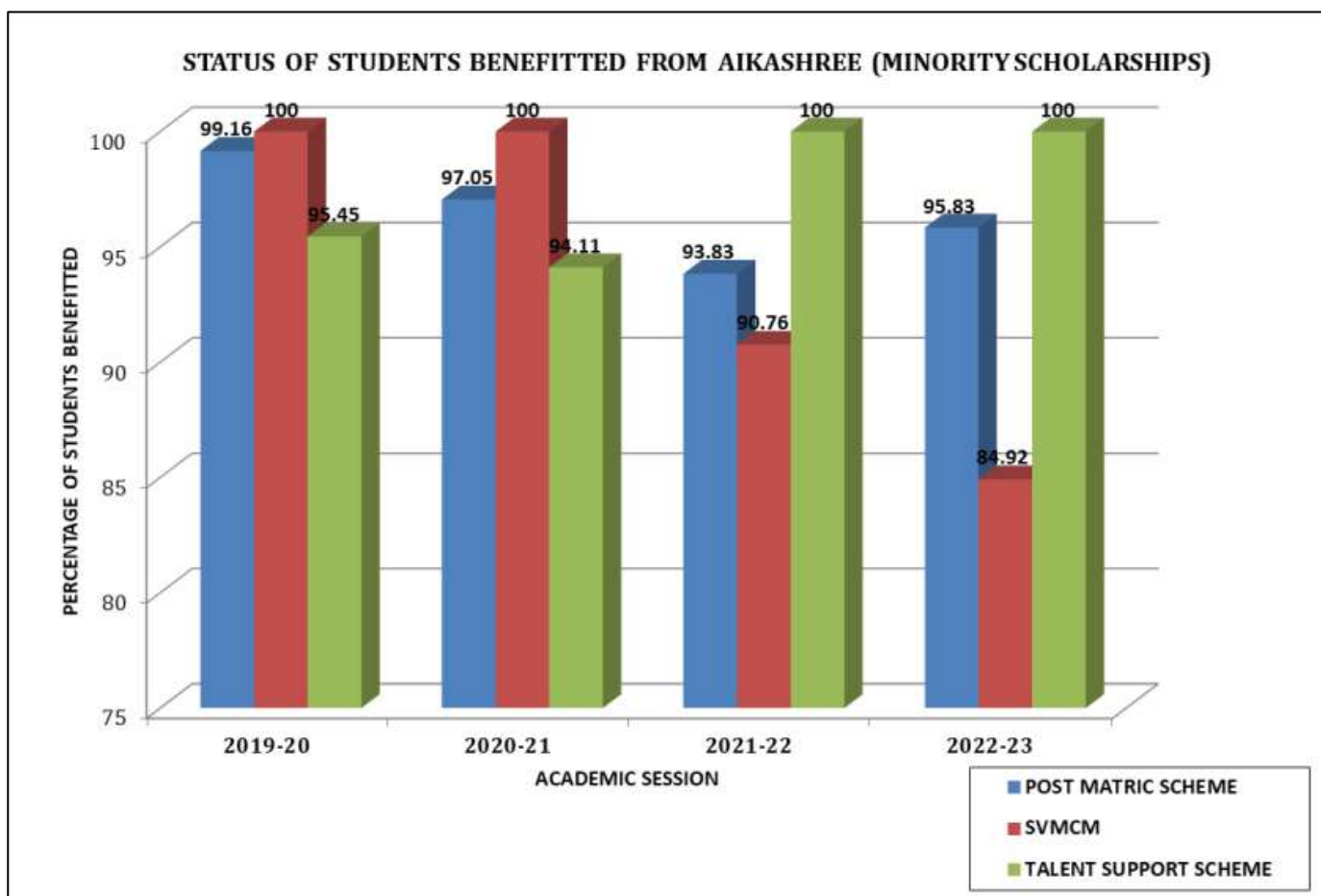

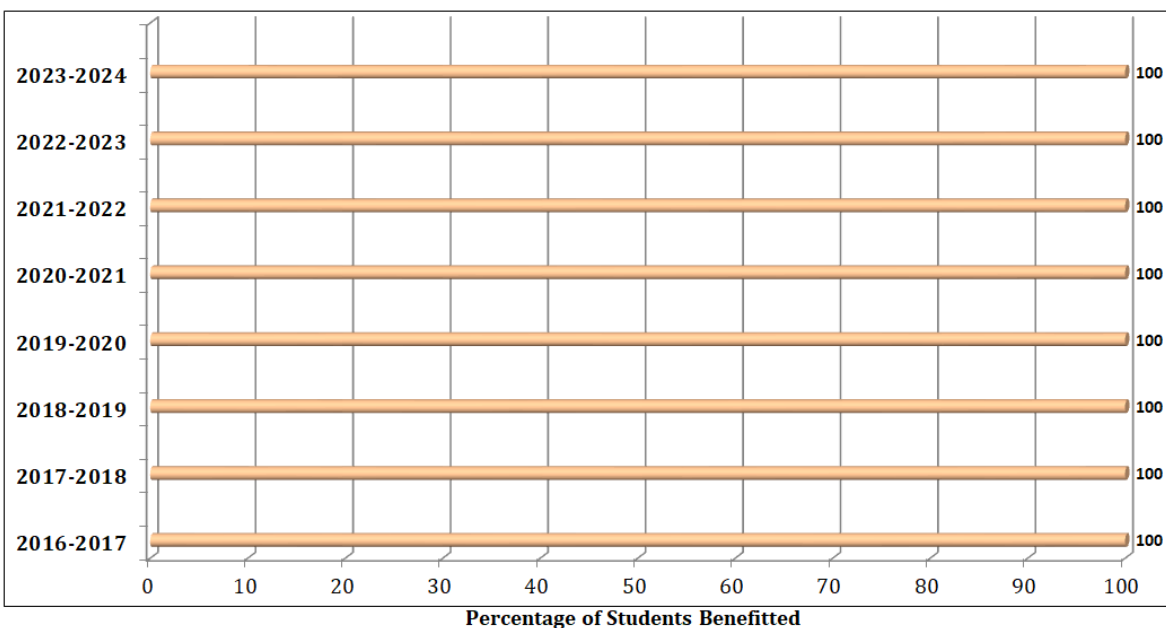

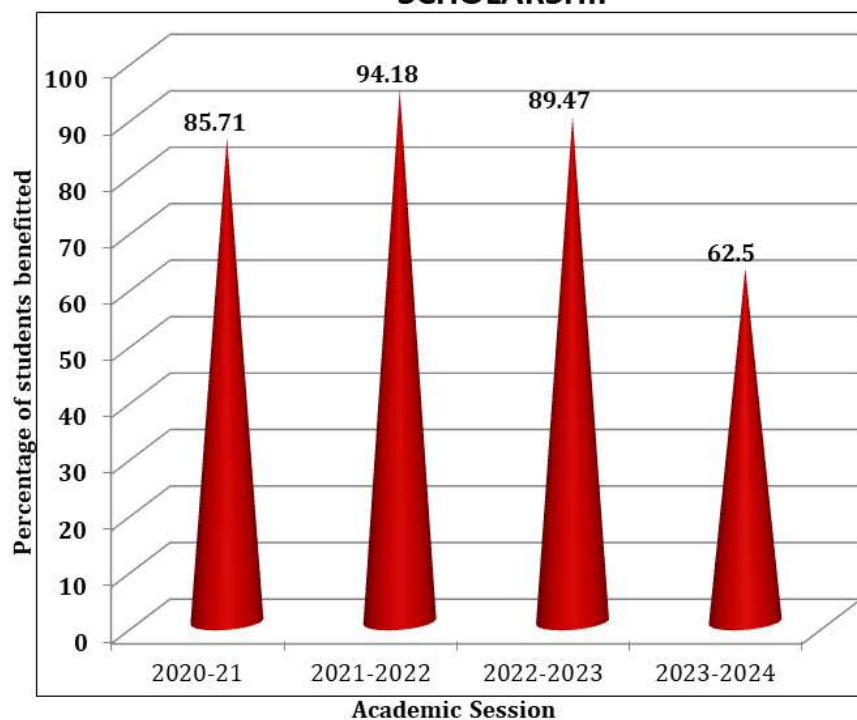

Scholarship received from WB Urdu Academy

A total of **05 students** also received one time scholarship grant of **Rs. 5400/-** from WB Urdu Academy for scoring more than 85% marks at their 10+2 level examination. All of these students belong to the Urdu Department of the College received the scholarship grant at their 1st Year Graduation course.

Note : It is to mention here that for all types of scholarships like Aikashree, Kanyasree, OASIS, there are three separate nodal officers from the institute who verify all the documents before referring them to the district level for approval . The students apply for the scholarships with required documents in respective portal of the scholarships online. Later on the verifications of all documents are done by the Nodal Officers from the portal for institute level verification . Once this process gets completed then these applications get forwarded to the next district level approval. Finally, after state level verification of all necessary documents the students are selected for the final payment of scholarship amount in their respective bank accounts whose details are furnished by the student during application stage online.

The students are made aware about all these scholarship facilities during the Orientation day by the members of the subcommittee and are categorically instructed not to apply for more than one scholarship at one time.

There is no nodal officer for the Urdu Academy scholarships. The students directly apply for Scholarships to the academy and based on documents of the students the Academy decides the list of students to be awarded with the scholarships .
